

ADVERTISEMENT FOR THE POST OF MULTIPURPOSE HEALTH WORKER (MALE)
UNDER NATIONAL VECTOR BORNE DISEASE CONTROL PROGRAMME.

Applications are invited from the Male candidates only to fill up the post of Multipurpose Health Worker (Male) for a period of 11 (eleven) months under the National Vector Borne Disease Control Programme of Sambalpur district. Cases of candidates of Sambalpur district will be given priority in selection. In case of non-availability of candidates from Sambalpur district, cases of candidates of immediate neighbouring district of Sambalpur can be taken in to consideration.

2. Total number of post vacant – 33 out of which 8 (eight) numbers of post reserved for Schedule Tribe candidates, 5 (five) numbers of post reserved for Schedule Caste candidates, 9 (Nine) numbers of posts reserved for S.E.B.C. candidates and 11 (eleven) numbers of posts reserved for unreserved category candidates.
3. The post will be filled up on contractual basis for a period of 11 (eleven) months on a monthly remuneration of Rs. 6000/- (Rupees six thousand) only. Considering their performances during the first 11 (eleven) months of services, further continuance of the candidates on contractual basis will be considered for subsequent period of 11 (eleven) months.
4. Eligibility -
 - (i) A candidate must have passed diploma in Pharmacy from either Government or recognised institution of Odisha and must have registered his name with Odisha Pharmacy Council.
 - (ii) The candidate must not be below the age of 18 (eighteen) years or above 32(thirty two) years as on 31.05.2011. The upper age limits shall be relaxed by 5 (five) years in case of S.T. and S.C. candidates and by 3 (three) years in case of S.E.B.C. candidates.
 - (iii) The candidates should have registered their names in the local Employment Exchange.
 - (iv) The application must be submitted by Speed post/Regd. Post to be reached in the office of the Chief District Medical Officer, Sambalpur on or before **31.05.2011 (31st May, 2011)** indicating on the envelope “ **APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF M.P.H.W. (MALE)** “.
 - (v) The name of the applicants will be arranged in order of merit, according to their total mark scored and percentage obtained in two examination of Diploma in Pharmacy. In case a candidate has not cleared D. Pharm examination both first and second year in one attempt then in that case 1% (one percent) of mark from total marks scored in each examination of the year will be deducted while preparing the merit list. No weightage shall be given for candidates having B.Pharm/M.Pharm qualification. Selection will be made irrespective of passing of Diploma in Pharmacy examination, in other words no preference will be given to earlier pass out over later pass out candidates.

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(vi) In case of otherwise qualified candidates but who are physically/mentally incapacitated to discharge the duties of the post of Multipurpose Health Worker (Male), their cases will not be considered for appointment.

5. The candidates selected for appointment may be required to undergo training as required for the post and they will discharge duties as per job chart prescribed by the authority.
6. In no case the candidates appointed in the post of M.P.H.W.(Male) will be considered for transfer to the post of Pharmacist although qualification for the both the post Multipurpose Health Worker (Male) and Pharmacist is same.
